

Driver's Privilege Agreement



Students who have a license may drive to school; however, they must strictly abide by the guidelines associated with that privilege.

Students' cars must be parked in the assigned area during the regular school day. Students should not be in their cars or in the parking lot around the cars during regular school hours without permission. Inappropriate music played on car sound systems will not be tolerated on campus any more that it would be in our classrooms. Also, reckless driving will not be tolerated. Students should drive slowly while on campus.

Students should carry no other passengers (exemption: immediate family members) to and from school unless written permission is given by both sets of parents and is filed in the office.

Any infraction of the above regulations will result in the loss of the driving privilege for a specified amount of time given by the principal.
