Dress Code

Elementary Dress Code (K5 – Grade 6)

Girls

- ❑ Jumpers and skirts should be purchased for girls. The approved colors are green plaid, gray, forest green, navy blue or khaki. The hem must cover the knee while sitting.
- ❑ Solid white, yellow blouses, or green, navy blue, light blue, black or white polos are required. Students should not wear crew neck pullovers or sweatshirts.
- ❑ Solid forest green white or black cardigan or V-neck pullover sweaters are acceptable. Please, do not purchase crewneck pullovers, hooded sweaters, or sweatshirts.
- ❑ Solid color socks or tights must be worn
- ❑ Hats, coats, jackets, sunglasses, etc. should not be worn in the building.
- ❑ PE sweatpants or shorts must be worn under the uniform for recess.
- ❑ Black sweatpants or shorts, white or gray shirts, white socks and sneakers are to be worn for Physical Education.
- ❑ Clogs, split-toe shoes, etc. may not be worn. Sandals are permitted as long as they have a strap on the heel. Sneakers will be allowed for Grades K5 – 6 provided they are in good condition.

Boys

- ❑ Gray, navy blue, black or khaki dress pants are to be worn.
- ❑ Belts must be worn with pants that have belt loops.
- ❑ White button-down oxfords, or navy blue, light blue, white, green or black polos are required.
- ❑ Solid forest green or black cardigan or V-neck pullover sweaters are acceptable. Students should not wear crewneck pullovers or sweatshirts.
- ❑ Hats, coats, jackets, sunglasses, etc. should not be worn in the buildings. Sneakers will be allowed for Grades K5 – 6 provided they are in good condition.
- ❑ Black, sweatpants or shorts, white or gray shirts, white socks and sneakers are to be worn for Physical Education.

All Students

Once an outfit has been deemed inappropriate, that outfit should not be worn again on campus. Students may not come inappropriately dressed whether before, during or after school hours. Dress code is also appreciated during summer or holiday visits to the campus.

Dress Code

Junior / Senior High School Dress Code (Grade 7 – Grade 12)

Young Ladies

- ❑ Clothing stressing modesty should be worn.
- ❑ Dresses/Skirts must cover the knee when sitting. The top of slits on dresses and skirts should be no higher than the bottom of the knee. Denim dresses and skirts in good condition may be worn.
- ❑ White button-down oxfords, or polos are required.
- ❑ Solid forest green or black cardigan or V-neck pullover sweaters are acceptable. Students should not wear crewneck pullovers or sweatshirts.
- ❑ Proper undergarments (slips, etc.) are mandatory.
- ❑ Casual clothing should be avoided. For example, T-shirts, sweatshirts, etc. are not acceptable.
- ❑ Hats, coats, jackets, sunglasses, etc. should not be worn in the buildings. Hooded sweaters/sweatshirts are not to be worn during classes, unless deemed necessary by the teacher.
- ❑ Black sweatpants or shorts, white, gray, or green shirts, white socks and sneakers are to be worn for Physical Education.
- ❑ Sneakers may not be worn for regular classes except for Physical Education classes. Sandals and clogs are permitted provided they are in good condition and appropriate. Flip-flops are not permitted, except on special dress down days.
- ❑ Makeup may be used in moderation.
- ❑ No bleached, dyed or extreme hairstyles are permitted.

Young Men

- ❑ Clothing should fit comfortably. Tight fitting clothing or extremely baggy styles are not appropriate. Avoid fads in clothing.
- ❑ White button-down oxfords, or polos are required.
- ❑ Solid forest green or black cardigan or V-neck pullover sweaters are acceptable. Students should not wear crewneck pullovers or sweatshirts.
- ❑ Shirts must be buttoned with the exception of the top button and must be tucked in at all times.
- ❑ Conservative dress slacks are expected. No jeans, sweatpants, or camouflage pants are allowed. There should be no extra pockets on the legs. Pants should be worn at the waistline at all times and should not be allowed to hang at or below the hips.
- ❑ Belts must be worn with pants that have belt loops.

Dress Code

- ❑ Casual Clothing should be avoided. For example, jean shirts, T-shirts, sweatshirts, sleeveless shirts, etc are not acceptable.
- ❑ Hats, coats, jackets, sunglasses, etc. should not be worn in the buildings. Cardigan sweaters and v-neck sweaters are acceptable inside attire if needed for warmth.
- ❑ Socks are required
- ❑ Black sweatpants or shorts, white, gray, or green shirts, white socks and sneakers are to be worn for Physical Education.
- ❑ Sneakers are not to be worn for regular classes except for Physical Education classes. Sandals and shoes without backs are unacceptable.
- ❑ No necklaces, bracelets, or earrings should be worn.
- ❑ Face must be clean-shaven.
- ❑ Haircuts must be conservative in style:
 - No bleached or dyed hair
 - The neckline and the sides should be gradually tapered leaving no hair touching the collar and ears.
 - No multi-layering – bowl cuts, etc.
 - The bangs should be off the eyebrows.
 - Sideburns should be no longer than the middle of the ear.
 - Flat tops need to be kept neatly trimmed.
 - No spiked hairstyles are acceptable.

All Students

Once an outfit has been deemed inappropriate, that outfit should not be worn again on campus. Students may not come inappropriately dressed whether before, during or after school hours. Dress code is also appreciated during summer or holiday visits to the campus.

Best Dressed Days

- ❑ Significant days throughout the year will be deemed “Best Dressed Days”.
- ❑ Young ladies should “dress up”; denim and jean materials will not be appropriate.
- ❑ Young men should wear a white shirt with an appropriate tie. Ties should be worn properly and neatly.

Dress Code for Special Events

Dress code for special events such as sporting events (traveling to and from the event), music or fine arts events, field trips, and banquets will be addressed by the principal in a timely fashion. Modesty and testimony will be the principles which guide such dress code decisions.

Dress Code

Parents in attendance at special events are asked to wear attire equal to the student dress code for that event. When parents visit school, assist in class parties, or field trips, they are requested to abide by the LCA dress code for that particular event. LCA does not necessarily expect parents to abide by the hair code, but does request the cooperation of parents in supporting hair code requirements for LCA students.

The Principal must approve any exceptions to the dress code prior to the event.
